I can't believe we are already in May and firmly into the camping season. I am enjoying hearing about plans that people have for taking their sections away and also seeing lots on social media about outdoor activities that are taking place.

You will all know by now that Wendy Tatham will take over from me as CC in July. I am delighted with this appointment and am confident that Wendy will do a great job. She and I are already working together on decisions and ensuring that she is up to speed on what's happening. I'm sure you will get a chance to meet her soon too. This means we now have almost 7,500 young people and almost 10,000 total membership in Oxfordshire. Whilst Scouting isn't about targets, we did set ourselves goals a few years ago and I'm pleased that this year's census sees us hitting the numbers on time! As well as overall growth, it's great to see that Explorer Scouts grew really significantly, contributing to us now having 26% of our youth membership aged 12+ and girls also now make up 26% of total members too.

We have recognised the fantastic work of a number of volunteers with good service awards in recent months. I would particularly like to congratulate our St George's Day award recipients: Roger "Bosun" Padgham (Silver Wolf), Sarah Joyner (Bar to the Silver Acorn) and Dawn Hopkins, Anna Harris, Krys Daniels, Kevin Heydon, Naomi Heydon, David Ralphs, Colin Whitlock, Ron Shewry, Mike Bowden, Ben Smith, Jill Elliot and Shelia Sangster (Silver Acorn). Well done and thank you to you all.

Finally, our 6th County Awards Day was held recently which celebrated the achievement of 900 young people who have gained top awards in their sections. This means that we have now seen over 5,000 awards made in the last 6 years! This really does go to show just how much good Scouting is happening around our patch and is testament to the work that you are all doing with our young people. I'd like to finish by sharing an email that we received from the parent of an award recipient after Awards Day. The message is very clear and was a brilliant reminder to me ... this is what we all do as Scouting volunteers. "My twin sons were receiving their first Bronze Award so it was an eye opener when we arrived to see such a huge set up and so many Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorer Scouts and Leaders involved. With so many on site, the organisation must be a nightmare, however, as a first timer, it was certainly v. impressive and we thank you for all the hours volunteering that everyone has put into making yesterday happen. It was a wonderful day, with a slick presentation of many awards, and then a wonderful selection of activities to follow. The boys know how lucky they are (to some degree) to be a part of the scouting community because you offer them so many opportunities that we as parents can't. There was just a fantastic BIG family feel about yesterday and that is testament to everything and every hour that everyone does to enable a day like yesterday happening. We as parents are very proud of their achievement, we hope that they are inspired to go further and can only thank you all for your time and dedication to putting smiles on faces and allowing young people to live their dreams."
